## NOTES

1. This form should be used for the following purposes:
  - (a) when any imported goods, are to be entered for home consumption (including goods subject to excise equivalent duty removed from a Customs controlled area); or
  - (b) where imported goods are to be removed to a manufacturing area for further manufacture; or
  - (c) where any imported goods are required to be moved to a Customs controlled area licensed for the purposes of section 10(b) of the Act, or regulation 6(b) of the Regulations.
2. Where goods are entered in relation to 1(b) and (c) above the purpose of the entry should be indicated by specifying the code for that Customs controlled area.
3. In all cases a properly completed "Customs Delivery Order" form should accompany the entry at the time of lodgement.
4. This form may be lodged at any Customs office.
